


- This year it's different

- Use your own call sign
- Submit your own entry
- PART score is the sum of the members' scores

## **Biggest Field Day Ever?**



• Field Day info and rules are at: http://www.arrl.org/field-day





- Objective: Work as many US/Canada stations as possible.
   DX stations can be contacted too.
- Bands: 160, 80, 40, 20, 15, 10, and 50 MHz and above
- Time: 1800 UTC (2:00 PM) Saturday, June 27, to 2059 UTC (5:00 PM) Sunday, June 28. Max of 24 consecutive hours.



Classes of stations (assume 1 XMTR)

•1E

✓ Home station on emergency power

•1D

✓ Home station on commercial power

•1C

✓ Mobile station

The number indicates how many transmitters are simultaneously in use



Portable stations (1 or 2 operators)

- Must be portable can't use home system or antennas
- 1B/2B: one or two person
- 1B/2B-Battery: one or two person
  - ✓ 5 watts or less
  - ✓ No commercial power or motor-driven generator
- Class B stations that don't begin setup until 2:00 PM on Saturday can end operations at 5:00 PM Sunday (27 hours).



#### **QSO** Points

- Phone: 1 point
- CW: 2 points
- Digital: 2 points
- Cabrillo file or dupe sheet required with entry



#### **Power multipliers**

- QRP : 5x
  - $\checkmark$  5 watts or less
  - ✓ No commercial power or motoroperated generator
- Low Power: 2x
  - ✓150 watts or less

Power multiplier applies to all contacts made by at the highest power used



- •All stations are eligible for bonus points
- These can increase your score a LOT with little effort
- Some bonus points are only available to certain classes of stations



#### Media Publicity

- 100 Points
- Attempt to obtain publicity from local media
- Submit a copy of press release or actual publicity to obtain points



#### Message to Section Manager

- 100 Points
- Formal message to ARRL SM or SEC
- Must be originated during FD in ARRL radiogram format via RF
- See rules for content



#### Message Handling

- 10 points for each origination, relay, or delivery up to 100 Points
- Doesn't include message to SM/SEC
- Must be originated during FD in ARRL radiogram format via RF



#### W1AW Bulletin

- 100 Points
- Voice, CW (18 wpm), or Digital (PSK-31, RTTY, MFSK-16)
- Accurate copy must be submitted with entry
- Bulletin schedule is in the rules



#### Site Visit by Elected Gov't Official

- 100 Points
- Must be invited





#### Site Visit by Agency Rep.

- 100 Points
- Agencies served by ARES (ex.: Red Cross, MEMA, law enforcement, etc.)
- ARRL officials don't count
- Must be invited



#### Web Submission

- 50 Points
- Submit FD entry via ARRL web site





#### **Youth Participation**

- Up to 100 Points
- 20 points for each person 18 or younger who completes at least one QSO.
- Class B stations have a twoperson maximum



#### 100% Emergency Power

- 100 Points
- All <u>transmitting</u> equipment\* at the site must operate from a power source completely independent of the commercial power mains to qualify.

\* Includes computer used to operate the transmitter Classes B, C, and E only



#### **Public Location**

- 100 Points
- Locate the station in a public place for display.





#### **Public Information Table**

- 100 Points
- Make appropriate handouts and information available to the visiting public at the site





#### **Satellite QSO**

- 100 Points
- Complete at least one QSO via Amateur Radio satellite
- Additional satellite QSOs count as normal contacts

#### **Class B only**



#### **Alternate Power**

- 100 Points
- Complete at least five QSOs without using power from commercial mains or petroleum driven generator. This includes batteries charged by natural means

#### **Classes B and E only**



**Categories We're Not Eligible For:** 

- Educational Activity. Must have three or more participants
- GOTA. Only for classes A and F
- Social Media. Must welcome visitors to your site. Not for single-op stations.
- Safety Officer: Class A only

## **Making Contacts**



- Any station can work any other station for points, once per band per mode
- Repeater contacts not allowed
- Field Day exchange: Type of station and ARRL Section:
  - o "1D Eastern Massachusetts"
  - **"1E EMA"**
  - o "1B Echo Mike Alfa"
- ARRL/RAC section list is in the Field Day Rules

## Making Contacts



- Field Day is for Techs, too!
- •10 Meters can surprise you
- Contacts made on repeaters don't count, but...

Use the WB1GOF repeater to ask for simplex contacts

• 146.52 MHz at 3:00 PM on Saturday

## **Making Contacts**



Example: A Technician makes five simplex contacts using a 5-watt HT with batteries charged by solar power (Class E)

- > 5 points for the contacts
- > 5x multiplier for QRP
- > 100 points for Emergency Power
- > 100 points for Alternate Power
- > 50 points for web submittal

#### 275 Points!

## **Logging Contacts**



- Contact list (not a log) must be submitted with entry
- Cabrillo file or dupe sheet
- Most computer loggers can
  produce a Cabrillo file
- Dupe sheets are on ARRL FD site • Manually fill in with stations contacted, then scan, photo, or mail it to ARRL for submittal

## **Dupe Sheets**



- Rules also state that the "dupe sheet" can be an "alpha/numeric list sorted by band and mode."
- Export your log to a spreadsheet for the listing and sorting, then print a PDF and use that for your web submission.

## Entry



- Entry must be submitted by July 28 – one month after Field Day ends
- Entry can be submitted by web, email, or mail. Only web entry gets 50 point bonus.

#### **2020 Field Day Entry - Introduction**

To submit your entry for Field Day, you'll need both the data that describes your entry and any required bonus point documentation. Although the bonus point documentation can be submitted at a later time, it's recommended that you submit both at the same time.

Data Entry. You'll need all of the info that describes your entry:

- Call used and GOTA station call
- Entry class, number of participants, list of operators
- Power source and multiplier
- Claimed bonus points
- QSO totals by band and mode
- GOTA operators and QSO totals

Upload Documents. If you elect to upload required documents at this time, you'll need files for the following:

- Cabrillo log or list of stations worked by band/mode (dupe sheet)
- Required documentation for bonus points

Go To Data Entry









- If you make an error on the web entry, you can resubmit. ARRL will send you an email with instructions for editing.
- Read the entry form BEFORE Field Day so you'll know what documentation you need.
- You've got a month to submit the entry. Ask for help if you need it.
